About The Theme

The institution of impartial and independent judiciary is of paramount significance because of its capability of serving the needs of the society and its craving for justice. The Indian Constitution has provided a beautiful system of checks and balances under articles 124(2) and 217(1) for appointment of Judges of Supreme Court and High Courts where both the executive and the judiciary have been given a balanced role. But this delicate balance has been upset by the 2nd Judges' case (Supreme Court Advocates-on-Record Association Vs. Union of India) and the opinion of the SC in the Presidential Reference (Special Reference No.1 of 1998) and thereby establishing a 'Collegium' of SC judges headed by the CJI for selection of judges to the Supreme Court and High Courts. Thus the Judiciary overruled the clear intention of framers of Constitution for imposing judicial supremacy over constitutional democracy.

Hence, with a view to analyze the existing process of judicial appointment in India as established by the judicial precedent and examine all the pros and cons of the said scheme, the Law Department of Invertis University is organizing two days National seminar, which will certainly educate and enlighten the students of law department in particular and contribute to the general advancement of knowledge relating to the issue of judicial appointments in India.

- A key issue of Judicial independence in the Appointment in Higher Judiciary.
- National and International Perspective of Judicial Appointment in the Present Scenario
- Mechanisms for maintaining judicial Independence and Transparency in the judiciary.
