Description: RI Club of Invertis University coordinated Stop polythene campaign on 21 April 2020 at Nagar Nigam Bareilly. The "Stop Polythene Campaign" was initiated to address the critical issue of environmental pollution caused by the rampant use and disposal of polythene or plastic bags. This report aims to highlight the progress, challenges, and impact of the campaign since its inception.

Campaign Objectives:

- 1. Raise Awareness: Educate the public about the adverse effects of polythene on the environment, wildlife, and human health.
- 2. Reduce Usage: Encourage the community to adopt eco-friendly alternatives to polythene.
 - Promote Responsible Disposal: Emphasize proper disposal methods and recycling practices. Activities Undertaken:
