Lansdowne is a hill station situated in the district of Garhwal, Uttarakhand. A beautiful hill station in the lap of the Himalayas, cradled by the whispering willows and the sweet invigorating winds. Its opulent surroundings have an essence of the British legal period. Being maintained by the cantonment Garhwal Rifles the place is clean and peaceful. The place is known for its military history, having many old buildings of British architecture.

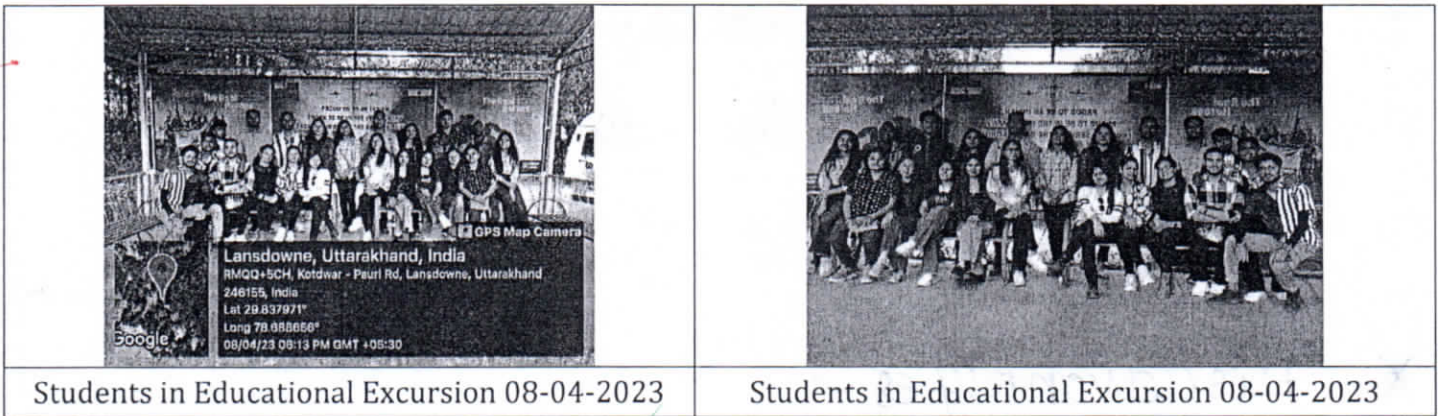
The beautiful sightseeing places in Lansdowne are Bulla Lake, Tip N Top, St. John’s Church, Darwen Singh Regimental Museum, Lord Shiva, and Kal Eshwar Mahadev temple.

A quiet town with old-world colonial charm, Lansdowne is an unspoiled expanse of lush greenery nestled in the Himalayas. The hill station is dotted with pines and oaks and is perched at a height of 1,700 m. charming churches, flowering thickets, springs, and ponds encompass the entire hill station. Lansdowne was established in 1887 as a cantonment of the British, who were drawn to its salubrious climate and is named after the then Viceroy of India, Lord Lansdowne. Today, it is the headquarters of the Garhwal Rifles of the Indian Army.

On **8th April 2023**, students of **B.Sc.-B.Ed. 6th Semester** with 3 Assistant Professors Deepika Mishra, Raghavendra Rastogi, and Rangoli Krishna went on a Trip to Lansdowne, Uttarakhand to make the students explore the beauty of the hill station.

Keeping in mind the importance of real-life exposure in education, the field trip provides a chance for students to mobilize their learning by socializing with peers and strangers in a completely different way than many of them had before. Students explore the small town on foot, with a lake at its center, enjoy nature walks and discover hidden temples and churches and enjoy the pristine mountain views.
