









As per the recommendation of the Course Review Committee (CRC) and the subsequent discussion held by the Programme Review Committee (PRC), a meeting of the Board of Studies (BOS) was held. The following points emerged from the discussion:

1. The minutes of the IV BOS meeting were read out and the compliance report was presented to the Board.
2. It was decided to make teaching more practical-centric, in line with the recommendations of the CRC and PRC. Faculty members were asked to design their knowledge-imparting methods in such a way that they go beyond the lecture method. The BOS **approved** this decision.
3. In accordance with the CRC and PRC's recommendations, the practicum syllabus for paper BMC151 was changed to include personality development and communication skills-based activities. The practicum syllabus for paper BMC152 was also changed to include more recreational activities and events. The BOS **approved** these changes.
4. The BOS **approved** the CRC and PRC's recommendation to update the practicum syllabus for paper BMC251 in line with new media. The updated syllabus will include advanced ICT-enabled learning.
5. The BOS **approved** the CRC and PRC's recommendation to update the practicum syllabuses for papers BMC351 and BMC352.
6. The BOS **approved** the CRC and PRC's recommendation to update the practicum syllabuses for papers BMC451 and BMC452.
7. The BOS **approved** the CRC and PRC's recommendation to update the practicum syllabuses for papers BMC551 and BMC552.
8. The BOS **approved** the CRC and PRC's recommendation to update the practicum syllabus for paper BMC651.
9. All changes made by the BOS will be effective from the academic session 2021-2022.
