Sub: Enquiry in connection of whether AICTE Approval is mandatory for Private University – Regarding.

Dear Sir,

Please refer to your letter no. IU/2014/40439 dated 17th May, 2014 addressed to the Chairman, AICTE on the above mentioned subject.

2. The issue as to whether the University should seek prior approval of the All India Council for Technical Education to start a department for imparting a course or programme in technical education or a technical institution as an adjunct to the University itself to conduct technical courses of its choice and selection, came up for consideration before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the matter of Bharathidasan University & Anr Vs. All India Council for Technical Education & Ors (2001 (8) SCC 676). The Hon'ble Supreme Court after considering various provisions of AICTE Act including section 10 (k), Section 2 (h) and 2 (i) of the AICTE Act, 1987, held that the prior approval of AICTE for starting technical course or programme by a University is not mandatory. That in view of the above pronouncement of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, the prior approval of AICTE for starting a technical course or programme by a University is not mandatory. This is for your information and necessary action.
