

Academic Administrative Audit Committee Recommendation

The committee members reviewed the data submitted by the various departments and based on the observations suggested the following measures for the overall improvement of the University.

- 1. The Departments like Biotechnology, Mechanical, CS & E, Computer Applications and Applied Sciences has the potential to do well in the field of research and innovation. These departments should explore the facilities available in campus for promotion of research and innovation activities.
- 2. The departments like Agriculture, Pharmacy, Education and Fashion Designing should focus more on Information and communication technology (ICT) tools during lectures. They may use interactive panels, projectors and software related to their course curriculum.
- 3. Each department on an average organized a mega event in the form of workshops or conferences during the year. The events organized especially conferences and workshops should be organized in collaboration with professional bodies and funding should be applied to various funding bodies.
- 4. The involvement of the students in events of other institutions like conferences/workshops should be increased for the exposure of the students. This will motivate the students to compete at state and national level for awards and recognitions.
- 5. The life memberships of the professional bodies are very less in number. The faculty members may be promoted to join life memberships of the Professional Bodies for establishing fruitful collaborations in R & D.
- 6. The final semester students of almost every department got an opportunity to work in industry or institute for practical exposure. It is a good initiative however, the students may also be recommended for short term training during semester breaks to enhance their exposure in the relevant field.



7. It is suggested that the university should take initiative to promote skill and entrepreunership development among students especially of professional courses to nurture their talent by enlightening them on various aspects of industrial/business activity required for start-ups.

The above recommendations/suggestions by the committee members may please be placed in the next IQAC meeting for discussion and incorporation of the same in the curriculum of the university.
