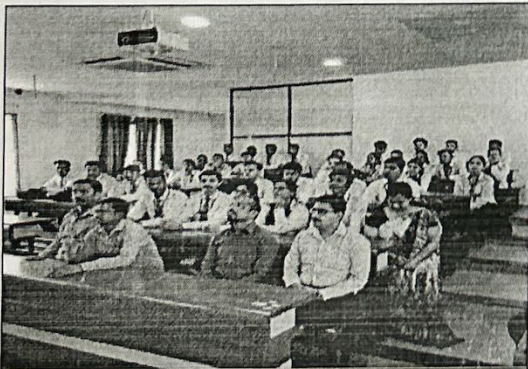

Objectives of the workshop:

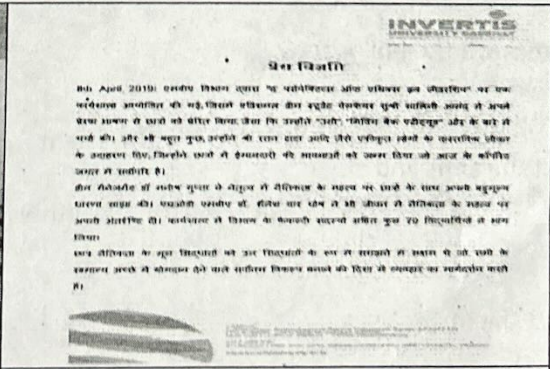
- To help students develop the critical thinking skills that will enable them to give voice to their values formed by character-based education.
