

Description:

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Invertis University organized a one-day workshop on "Quality Assurance and Accreditation in Higher Education" on 8th June 2020. The workshop aimed to familiarize the participants with the significance of assessment and accreditation in the higher education landscape. It also provided insights into the revised accreditation framework by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) and encouraged the exchange of experiences and best practices to enhance educational quality.

The workshop commenced with a warm welcome and introduction by the IQAC coordinator, emphasizing the significance of quality assurance and accreditation in shaping the future of higher education institutions. Distinguished educationists and experts in the field were invited as resource persons to share their insights and experiences throughout the day.

A total of 160 participants benefited from this event. The list of programs included in this event was inaugural session, talks by guest speakers, Q&A session summarization, concluding remarks, valedictory session, and vote of thanks. At the end of the program the convener has taken the feedback from the participates and the key takeaways from the feedbacks are: participants gained a clear understanding of the significance of accreditation in higher education.
