The purpose of the meetings was initially to be a forum for unbounded political debate which may not be allowed in Parliament due to time constraints but these bodies now aid in providing a better insight into national issues. They help provide a diverse viewpoint before the actual legislative process.

Rules and Regulations:

- 1. There will be individual participation.
- 2. The participants shall report 15 minutes before the time provided.
- 3. Formal dressing is required. It would be appreciated for wearing an attire similar to the roleplay given carrying it in decent manner.
- 4. Participants may use bilingual language during their speech. (Hindi and English)
- 5. Roleplay would be allotted according to number you choose in Registration form and will be revealed before the event itself
- 6. Participants should seek confirmation of their registration prior to last date of registration.
- 7. Participants creating any kind of indiscipline shall be disqualified on the discretion of the judges.
- 8. Participants thereby should adhere by the rules and regulations of the event.
- 9. Attire Indian/Western formals to be strictly followed.
- 10. Indian Wear is encouraged.
- 11. Laptops, mobile phones, tablets etc. are allowed but parliamentarians (participants) are not allowed to assess internet for further research.







Research sources should not include Wikipedia, it should be from a reliable source

- 12. No internet usage allowed for research inside the house i.e. once the event starts.
- 13. The participants should show utmost respect to the Chair (judges)
- 14. They should abide by the decisions of the Chair (judges) and should have faith in his impartiality and judgment. The participants are encouraged to tap desks in agreement.
- 15. One may not argue on points, which are nowhere related to the debate, this may fetch you negative marks.
- 16. One may not use any unparliamentarily word while the house is in session. One may have to apologize (in oral or written) for the same. Placards shall be present with the participants of their respective roleplay they are allotted.




