1. *Suspension*
2. *Withdrawal of scholarship and other benefits.*
3. *Debarring from appearing in any examination.*
4. *Withholding results.*
5. *Debarring from representing the Institution in any national or international meet.*
6. *Expulsion from the Institute and consequently debarring from admission to any Institution.*
7. *Cancellation of admission.*
8. *Registration of a case under appropriate sections of law.*
9. *Rigorous imprisonment up to three years.*

The quantum of punishment shall, naturally, depend upon the nature and gravity of the offence established by the Court of law.

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NOTICE

On receipt of the recommendations of the anti ragging squad or on receipt of any information concerning any incidents of ragging, the head of the university shall immediately determine if a case under the penal laws is established and if so, either on his own or through a member of the anti-ragging committee authorized by him on his behalf, proceed to file a first information report (FIR), within 24 hours of receipt of such information or recommendation, with the police, under the appropriate panel provisions relating to one or more of the following:

- *Abetment to ragging*
- *Criminal conspiracy to rag*
- *Unlawful assembly and rioting while Ragging*
- *Public nuisance created during ragging*
- *Violation of decency and morals through ragging*
- *Injury to body, causing hurt*
- *Wrongful restraint*
- *Wrongful confinement*
- *Use of criminal force*
- *Assault as well as sexual offence or unnatural offences*
- *Extortion*
- *Criminal trespass*
- *Criminal intimidation*
- *Attempts to commit any or all of the above mentioned offence against the victim.*
- *Physical or psychological humiliation.*
- *All other offences following from the definition of ragging*

Provided in future that the institution shall also continue with its own enquiry initiated under clause 9 of these regulations & other measures without waiting for action on the part of the police.

इंवर्टिस विश्वविद्यालय द्वारा आयोजित एंटी रैगिंग गतिविधि में छात्रों ने अपनाया नारा 'शिक्षा में बदलाव, रैगिंग को खत्म करें'

बरेली, 23 अगस्त 2020: इंवर्टिस विश्वविद्यालय ने एंटी रैगिंग गतिविधि आयोजित की जिसमें विद्यार्थियों ने सक्रियतापूर्वक हिस्सा लिया। यह कार्यक्रम प्रोफेसर जे एन श्रीवास्तव द्वारा होस्ट किया गया था।

इस गतिविधि का उद्देश्य छात्रों को एक सुरक्षित, न्यायपूर्ण और शोषण मुक्त शिक्षा प्रदान करना था। रैगिंग एक समस्या है जो बहुत सारे शिक्षा संस्थानों में देखी जाती है और इसका प्रभाव छात्रों के मानसिक, भावनात्मक और शारीरिक स्वास्थ्य पर होता है।
