

3. Institution organizes professional ethics programmes for students, teachers, administrators and other staff

Invertis University's mission and vision specifically mentions human values, social responsibility, ethical ideals, moral virtue, and a service-oriented faith. Value added course and personality development classes are few instances that were successfully implanted where students of hostels were given classes to develop their ethical values and personality along with the communication skills.
