Report on Anti-Ragging Activity Organized by Invertis University

Date: 9/8/2021

1. **Introduction:** Invertis University organized an Anti-Ragging Activity on 9/8/2021 to address the issue of ragging on campus and promote a safe and inclusive learning environment for all students. The event was addressed by Dr. J.N. Shrivastav, the Chief Proctor of the university. The objective of the activity was to create awareness about the harmful effects of ragging and to encourage students to report any incidents promptly.
2. **Background:** Ragging refers to any form of physical or psychological abuse, harassment, or humiliation inflicted on new students by their seniors.
