

The Department of Applied Science and Humanities Invertis University organized a Faculty Development Programme on Effective Teaching at college level for our faculty members on 22 August, 2015






Towards the end of the program, the participants were quite exuberant and werewilling to incorporate these learnings of the program in their daily lives.
