Item No. 16.PB.4.1: Welcome Address and brief introduction about policy perspective by Hon'ble Chancellor of the University.

The Planning Board was welcomed and addressed by the Chairman of the board, Dr. Umesh Gautam, who briefly introduced the ideas and the direction of future growth. A few important points of his address are summarized below.

The Chancellor informed about the approval of various courses by their respective councils. Invertis Institute of Architecture and Invertis Institute of Law got its approval from COA and BCI respectively for the next session. "Outstanding B-School and Engineering University" in the field of higher education has been conferred on Invertis University. Invertis University took a global dimension through collaboration with the "University of South Carolina Upstate" USA, for students and faculty exchange program. The University has also launched new age career and industry ready B.Tech programmes in "Cloud Computing & Information Security" and "Animation & VFX".

In placement field, Invertis made remarkable achievements. Placement activity 2015 ended with a mega job fair.

Results in last semester examinations (Even semester held in June 2015 and Odd Semester held in December 2015) are consistently better.

By and large, the academic growth is healthy and a humble attempt is made to lay a sound foundation for University System and it is hoped with the Co-operation of the authorities and faculty of the University, it should be possible to accomplish the task.

Item No. 14.PB.4.2: Regarding maintenance of infrastructure, improve the greenery and cleanliness of the campus.

This campus was built in the year 2001 and the we got the status of University in the year 2010. Many new buildings came as per requirement and at present there are more than 100 well equipped class rooms, computer labs of more than 500 terminals, engineering labs and workshops.

It was emphasized to keep the infrastructure updated and properly maintain the lush green Invertis campus and its cleanliness. It was also suggested to check whether all the equipment and machines in labs and workshops are functional and running smoothly.

It was suggested to inform about the requirement of any new equipment through proper channel well in advance so that it could be procured accordingly.

Item No. 14.PB.4.3: Approval of the retirement age of employee of Invertis University.

As per the discussion with Academic Advisor Prof. Bhagwati Prasad regarding the superannuation age and employment after the retirement, the following was proposed for approval:

- 1. The retirement age of faculty will be 62 years.
- 2. Retired faculty members can be given ad hoc appointment up to the age of 70 years for specific work and for a specified time period if they are physically fit and the University needs their services.
- 3. Faculty members above the age of 70 years can be appointed by invitation only for a specific work.
- 4. The retirement age of non-teaching staff will be 60 years.
- 5. Retired non-teaching staff can be given ad hoc appointment up to the age of 65 years for specific work and specific time period if



they are physically fit and the University (Management) need them.

The above mentioned proposals were already put up for information at the Academic Council and subsequently were approved by the Planning Board.

Item No. 14.PB.4.4: Planning for new courses to be introduced from next session.


Many members gave suggestions regarding coming convocation and advised a few issues that were experienced during the previous convocation.

He emphasized on quality education, discipline and good placement opportunities for students. Library was one of the focus areas which is very crucial for a good academic environment.

He also advised to integrate cultural and technical fest so that the proper utilization and awareness about technology could be achieved. Now a days, we are a part of Global Village, therefore, he pointed out the need of foreign collaboration in research and academic field.

By and large, it was observed that the academic growth is healthy and a humble attempt is made to lay a sound foundation for University System and he hoped that with the Co-operation of the authorities and faculty of the University, it should be possible to accomplish the task.

Item No. 17.PB.5.2: Planning for new courses to be introduced from next session.

The following new courses ware proposed to be started in Invertis University from the Academic Year 2017-18.

Item No. 17.PB.5.3: Planning for infrastructure, such as computers and LCD Projectors.

With more and more faculty using LCD Projector to improve their teaching, it was suggested to install LCD projectors in every classroom and it was suggested to provide the details of required number of projectors to be installed.

<u>Item No. 17.PB.5.4:</u> Planning for renewable and green energy sources for the energy requirements of the University.

The University was the first educational institute in Bareilly to go for 800kw solar plant to meet its energy requirements through renewable energy sources.

The plant is expected to be commissioned within a month.

<u>Item No. 17.PB.5.5:</u> Planning to merge cultural fest with tech fest to utilize the synergy.

It was felt that cultural and tech fest when organized separately, consume lot of time and resources. Therefore, it was proposed that both the events should be merged in one fest to save time and resources.


<u>Item No. 17.PB.5.6:</u> Suggestion to organize events like Inspire, Quiz Programme, etc.

The board suggested to organize events like quizzes, debates, seminars, painting competition, Inspire programme on regular basis.


Item No. 18.PB.6.6: Planning to conduct FDP, MDP, Seminars, Conferences, Workshops etc. on regular basis.

Invertis University publishes three journals in Management, Engineering and in Renewable Energy field. It was suggested to explore the options of online publication of all the three journals so that they could be easily available without any harmful effects on environment.

Item No. 19.PB.7.6: Motivation for organizing social events such as blood donation camps, etc.

Social responsibility is one of the objectives of any University. It was suggested to organize blood donation camps, distribute books and stationary to the poor children, conduct classes in the nearby villages to make them aware about the importance of education etc.

The planning board instructed the concerned authority to formulate a committee for NAAC Accreditation and start its work to achieve the accredited status latest by the end of the year 2020.


Item No. 19.PB.7.8: Planning for development and implementation of new ERP.

<u>Item No. 20.PB.8.1:</u> Welcome Address and brief introduction about policy perspective by Hon'ble Chancellor of the University.

The Planning Board was welcomed and addressed by the Chairman of the board, Dr. Umesh Gautam, who briefly introduced the ideas and the direction of future growth.

Item No. 20.PB.8.2: Planning for new courses to be introduced from next session.

The planning board proposed to start a few new courses from the next session. B.A. Honours in Economics and MA in English / Professional Communication was suggested. B.Ed. and M.Ed. courses were also suggested to be started whenever permitted by NCTE.

It was advised to look for the prospects for para medical courses that can be run under Invertis University.

<u>Item No. 20.PB.8.3: Planning for infrastructure, such as computers and LCD Projectors</u>

It was proposed that the computers installed in the labs are required to be updated and 100 to 150 new desktop computers are to be purchased with high end configuration to meet the system requirements of current as well as future technologies.

Item No. 20.PB.8.4: Suggestion for implementation of NPTL and other online course available.

As promoted by MHRD and UGC, online courses from NPTL should be included in our curriculum and weightage should be assigned for those courses.

Respective Deans and University coordinator of NPTL program were advised to prepare a blueprint to implement the scheme.

Item No. 20.PB.8.5: Planning to get the University accredited with NAAC certification.

The preparation for NAAC Accreditation started last year, the progress was reviewed and further requirements were discussed in the meeting of the planning board and it was instructed to submit the form in the year 2020 itself.

Item No. 20.PB.8.6: Planning for improvement in qualitative and quantitative placement of students

A higher education institution is known by its placement and alumnae. Therefore, the board instructed the placement in-charge (CRC Head) to improve the placement scenario of the students both qualitatively and quantitatively.

Item No. 20.PB.8.7: Planning for development and implementation of new ERP.

The University is using ERP since its inception. However, as the strength of students increased, the need for a new advanced ERP system was felt. Last year the University signed an agreement with one of the ERP venders to develop and customize new ERP system for the University, which is expected to be functional from the next coming session. The progress of the ERP system was reviewed.

The meeting ended with the vote of thanks by the Vice Chancellor.
