### a) Safety and Security

Invertis University, Bareilly is committed towards the promotion and practice of the ideals of social and natural justice, human dignity and rights of all human beings. Therefore, it realizes the significance and the need for having a Gender Harmony and Anti Sexual Harassment Policy and establishment of the Committee for safety and security whose foremost role and responsibility is to create an atmosphere free from any form of sexual discrimination and sexual harassment, prevention, prohibition and social security, counseling etc.

Invertis university takes care of the safety and security not only for the persons associated with Invertis University, Bareilly but also try to influence the people of nearby area. A women grievance Cell for redressal of grievances has been constituted to maintain safety and security of girls and Women at Invertis University. Our women grievance cell remains active all the time to prevent any sexual abuse towards the students and female workers.

Any student, staff or worker can complain at our women grievance in case of harassment or sexual abuse. The members of the Cell will look into the issues, gather the evidence, and take the necessary action against the guilty. Cell also takes precautionary measures to avoid any kind of harassment to females on the campus and stays vigilant all the time.

This cell is meant for maintaining the records of grievances, actions taken thereon and settlement of grievances. The cell is headed by the Dean Welfare, four lady faculty members and girl hostel wardens.

Special tab named complaint is introduced on our ERP system which accessible to all users, where our students or staff can submit grievances. Students or staff member are free to write applications, email or messages to Women grievance Cell in case of any harassment faced by them. Any grievance found is scrutinized and necessary actions are immediately taken by the Cell. In case of emergency, the head of Grievance calls a meeting along with proctorial board and addresses the problems immediately. During the last two years the cell is resolving the difficulties of the girl students 'grievances. It was settled harmoniously.

The members of Proctorial Board also look after the safety and security of girls and lady members of Invertis University.

To uphold Women's Right to create healthy and secure environment, Our University organized the following seminar/workshop.

### b) Counseling

Though University has policy to do the counseling in various levels including Class In charges, engaging professional counselor etc. and has taken special care for counseling in gender equality and gender harmony. It takes pro-active role in creating social, physical and psychological environment and awareness. Also encourage them to create a healthy environment in and around the campus. Awareness and counseling has been generated to ensure that complaints will be dealt with in a sensitive, equitable, fair, timely and confidential manner.


## c) Common Room



Discussion - Recently two major issues came up from the girls of academic block 3.


- 1. Using abusive language publicly.
