He basically elaborated on how your education and experience may make you eligible to apply for a job but, to be successful in most roles, you will need skills that you are likely to develop over time. Some will be specific to the job, but the vast majority will be so-called 'soft skills' that can be used in any job or employment sectors. These soft skills are 'employability skills': they are what makes you employable. As a general rule, employers are willing to teach someone the job-specific skills required, such as how to operate particular pieces of machinery or use particular computer packages that are very specific to that role or company. However, they usually want to see that you already have the other 'soft skills' before hiring, because they are much harder to teach. Being able to apply for a job in the right way, shine at interview and getting a job is not a key employability skill. The workshop also acquainted students with the different skills that are required to crack any interview. He also focused on the clarity of anything that you are studying or doing in your life. **Event Description:** The free spoken English classes, Speak Smart, were organized by I-Tech from Oct 05th 2015 to Oct 31st 2015. The classes were an effort of Team I-Tech and were taken by three students, Sarin Raj Pokhrel of B.Tech (Civil) 4th year, ArtiTyagi of B.Tech (Biotech) 3rd year and Sakshi Singh of B.Tech (Biotech) 3rd year. They aimed to improve the basic spoken language of the students, gradually taking them to higher and advanced level. The classes were open to students of all courses and streams and received an overwhelming response, much greater than that of last year.

We initially began with simple activities like word play, introduction of the students, conversations, newspaper reading, etc. The students were encouraged to speak more and more rather than focusing on just writing. Assignments like looking up one new word with its meaning each day were allotted to make them more committed towards the class. To break the ice and make them more confident and outspoken, we made sure that each student spoke in front of the entire class on any topic at least once daily. They were divided into pairs and groups to help them work on their conversing skills. General grammar like tenses, articles, types of sentences, etc were also brushed up in the classes. To make the classes more fun, simple games were organized for the students every day. Guest lectures were organized which were taken by Dr. RubinaVerma, HOD (PC).




