

Ph.D. Regulations and Procedure

Invertis University, Bareilly

1. Ph.D. Entrance Examination

1. The University shall conduct the Ph.D. Entrance Examination **twice in an academic year.**
2. The Entrance Examination shall normally be held in the months of **June** and **December.**
3. Admissions to the Ph.D. Programme shall be made based on the performance in the Entrance Examination, interview/viva-voce, and other criteria as prescribed by the University from time to time.

2. Course Work

1. Every admitted Ph.D. scholar shall be required to complete the prescribed Course Work in accordance with the provisions of the University and applicable regulatory guidelines.
2. Course Work classes shall be conducted in the following sessions:
 - **August to November** (Odd Semester)
 - **January to April** (Even Semester)
3. The Course Work shall comprise such courses, credits, and evaluation components as prescribed by the University.

3. Course Work Examination

1. The Course Work Examination shall be conducted **twice in an academic year.**
2. The examinations shall normally be held:
 - In **December** for the August–November Course Work session.
 - In **June** for the January–May Course Work session.
3. A scholar shall be required to secure the minimum prescribed grade/marks for successful completion of the Course Work.


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4. University Research Degree Committee (URDC)

1. The University Research Degree Committee (URDC) meetings shall be conducted **twice in an academic year**.
2. The URDC meetings shall normally be scheduled in the months of:
 - **April**
 - **September**
3. The URDC shall review research proposals/synopsis of Research Scholars, consider registrations, monitor compliance with regulations, and perform such functions as prescribed by the University.

5. Progress Report Submission

1. Every Ph.D. scholar shall submit a **Progress Report twice in an academic year** through the Research Supervisor(s) before RAC (Research Advisory Committee)
2. Progress Reports shall be submitted in the months of:
 - **April**
 - **September**
3. The Progress Report shall include details of research work carried out, achievements, publications, presentations, future work plan, and recommendations of the Supervisor(s).
4. The Progress Reports shall be reviewed by the appropriate RAC as prescribed by the University.
