Abstract submission

Abstracts of original articles related to theme of convention or any subject of pharmaceutical sciences, should be submitted online to appconv2015@gmail.com on/before 31st December, 2014 in MS Word format, Times New Roman (Font size 12), clearly indicating in which session (oral/poster) the work is to be presented. The title of the paper should be in capital followed by full names of all the authors. Presenting author name should be highlighted with asterisk and complete name of presenting author must be mentioned at the end of abstract followed by e-mail address. Author names should be followed by affiliation which should clearly indicate to which department authors belong to. Abstract should be single spaced throughout and should not exceed 300 words. Notification of accepted abstracts will be sent on/before 15th January, 2015. Abstracts not complying with instructions, will not be considered for presentation.

Presentation guidelines

Poster content should be divided into following sections - Title, Authors, Affiliation, Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results and Discussion, Conclusion and References. Poster should look attractive and should not exceed in size from 80 x 120 cm. Oral presentation time limit will be 15 min followed by 5 min discussion/questionnaire. Only selected abstracts will be considered for oral presentation. Proceedings of the convention will be published in special online issue of peer-reviewed international journal 'Bulletin of Pharmaceutical Research'. Authors of accepted abstracts (research papers) can send their full length papers for publication in the forthcoming issues of 'Bull. Pharm. Res.' for the year 2015.
